

Year-Long Artist in Residence Application

Postmark Deadlines: Early application: April 21, Regular application: May 31

Notification begins: in 2-3 weeks following deadline

Studio 550 is a community arts center located in the Gaslight District of Manchester, New Hampshire's downtown. This organization operates an artist residency program, a gallery exhibitions program, and an education/community outreach program. This year long residency is designed to provide artists with the opportunity to create and explore their work independently, while being a central element of a dynamic community-based arts center.

Studio 550 Provides:

- Private (key-access) studio space of about 100-120 square feet
- All utilities
- Use of two 500SF common studio areas when classes are not in session
- Studio facilities and equipment
 - Bulk ordering for studio materials
 - 2 electric kilns, 1 test kiln, local access to a soda and wood kiln (not at the art center, but at local artists' homes)
 - 10 studio wheels (artists are encouraged to bring their own for personal use)
 - Slab rollers
 - Raw materials room
- Workshop opportunities
- Teaching opportunities
- Website visibility and ongoing resident publicity
- Gallery exhibition opportunities
- Group exit/entrance exhibition

Duration: One year, beginning early September each year (with option to renew upon review)

Assistantship Opportunity: All applicants are considered for the assistantship position with the studio. This individual assists in Studio operations for 7-8 hours each week in full exchange for their studio space. The studio assistant will still be responsible for materials and firings.

Artists Provide: Residency fees are \$115/month for a private 100-120 sq. ft. studio. Upon acceptance, artists are asked to pay one month's fees as a security deposit and sign an artist's agreement to reserve their space in the program. If positions are available, artists may work additional hours for the art center to offset the costs.

Artist Responsibilities: Personal firing costs (if applicable), materials, and housing. Each non-assistantship resident is asked to give approximately 3 hours a week to help facilitate Studio 550 studio/gallery operations (responsibilities decided based on the artist's strengths and interests), participate in visiting artist events, and should be active in their studio at least 20 hours per week.

Application Process

Eligibility: Ideal candidates will be self-motivated and dedicated artists with a collaborative and socially conscious attitude, who are excited and energized about being one of the first in a new AIR Program. As such, artists will have opportunity to shape the character of the program. A BFA/BA is strongly recommended, and though an MFA will be helpful, it is not required. The program is open to local, regional, national, and international artists.

Image Requirements: Please submit 15-20 high quality images of your work created in the last two years. All images should be saved in .jpeg format at 72-300 dpi, at least 5x7", titled "applicant's last namefirst initial_image number" corresponding to the slide sheet (i.e . doej_1.jpeg, doej_2.jpeg, etc. for John Doe) Please no text on images, and please label the CD with your name.

Guiding Questions for your Narrative: This is your chance to tell us what makes you unique, because you most definitely are. What events or decisions in your life have shaped who you are today or brought you to where you are now? What are your life goals? What is it that you would like to explore during your time at Studio 550? What do you spend your time doing when you are not working in clay? You do not need to answer all of these questions, but please answer the ones that you think best reflect your honest self.

Selection Process: Up to five resident artists will be accepted per residency period, of which at least two will be ceramic artists (one functional and one sculptural). Studio 550 aims to select artists from a variety of backgrounds, media and experiences, from emerging artist to fully accomplished, as we believe in the creative value of diversity. Artists are selected based on the quality of their work, their narrative, and their interest in involvement in the surrounding creative environment. While quality of work is important, quality of character is paramount. The executive director and some current artists in residence will make up the selection committee. You may be contacted for an informal interview to make sure this space is appropriate for you.
