Unseen in the City

A Photographer's perspective of Manchester, NH

This is a photography show of uncommon views of the people or places in our city. Both professional and amateur photographers are welcome to submit work for consideration.

This is a call for photographs of any format, color, black and white, with a unique perspective of the city. The theme for the show can be interpreted either literally or figuratively. The subject matter is open, and may portray anything from cityscapes, details, people, places or anything else. Images may be purely visual, representational, or social commentary - shedding light on a particular issue, sharing the story of a population or place, for example.

Preference will be shown to images that interpret the theme creatively and portray Manchester positively. There will be a people's choice award and a staff choice award.

Call for Entries ARRIVE BY Deadline: December 2, 2013 5PM

ELIGIBILITY:

- Open to residents of the 50 United States and DC.
- Submitted work produced within the last two years.
- Work may not exceed 10 pounds in weight.

RULES:

- Applicants may enter 3 entries, plus two more for an additional fee
 - All exhibited work MUST BE FOR SALE.
 - Retail price must be under \$300/entry.
 - Specific piece(s) accepted MUST be available for entire exhibition. We will exhibit NO substitute pieces.
 - Work will be disqualified if it is not the same piece that was accepted or if it displays poor craftsmanship.
 - Work must arrive in time for the opening.
- Entries must be delivered ready to hang.

ENTRY FEE:

- \$25 for three entries, non-refundable check or money order made payable to Studio 550. Please don't send cash.
- Applicants may submit up to two more entries for \$10 each (i.e. 5 entries for \$50, 4 entries for \$40)

COMMISSION:

Studio 550 collects 40% of all retail sales of artwork sold, the artists receive 60% of sales.

FREIGHT AND INSURANCE:

The artist is responsible for freight and insurance on the work to and from this show. Studio 550 is responsible for insurance during the exhibition.

DIGITAL IMAGE REQUIREMENTS:

- Submit only one image per work entered
- Save images as a high quality JPG before you submit it.
- Images should be with resolution of 72 - 300 dpi
- Please no text on images
- Label CD with your name & show title, CD not returned.
- Label images with first four letters of your last name, your first initial, and entry number (A, B, C). (i.e. John Doe would be - doej_A.jpg, doej_B.jpeg, doej_C.jpeg)

PHOTOGRAPHY:

- Studio 550 reserves the right to photograph works, and use submitted photo materials of accepted pieces for the purposes of documentation, education, publicity, promotion and future grant proposals. Images of accepted work will not be returned.

Application:

All information is final, including selling prices and titles. All work must be for sale and may not exceed \$300 in value. All applications must be ARRIVED BY December 2, 2013 either emailed or hard copy. **E-Applications should be sent to info@550arts.com and the following entry information should be typed directly in the email (not this PDF filled out and scanned).**

Note: Incomplete information (i.e. no sizes) will give less information to the juror! Thank you for printing legibly.
